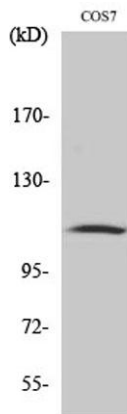

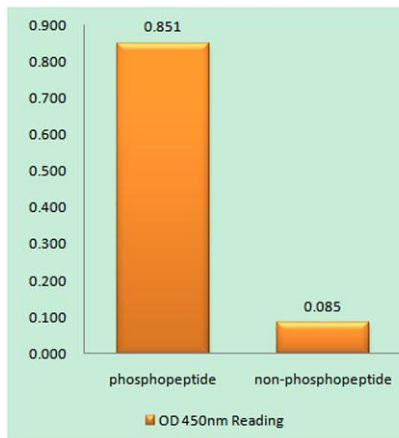

Immunogen	The antiserum was produced against synthesized peptide derived from human GAB1 around the phosphorylation site of Tyr627 AA range:611-643
Specificity	Phospho-Gab 1 (Y627) Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of Gab 1 protein only when phosphorylated at Y627.
Formulation	Liquid in PBS containing 50% glycerol, 0.5% BSA and 0.02% sodium azide.
Storage	Store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

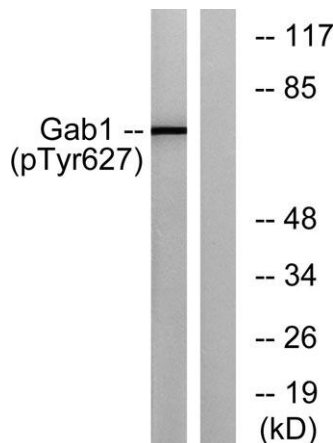
branching tubulogenesis and plays a central role in cellular growth response, transformation and apoptosis. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Aug 2008],
